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Your comic strip must:

- Be composed of at least 6 frames.
- Include 6 illustrations (hand drawn) in each frame depicting the Scientific Method.
- Feature short captions underneath it (in complete sentences) that provides details about what is occurring within each frame.
- Include the following terms in the frame captions (terms should be underlined):

1. Problem Make an Observation to Ask a Question
2. Make an Hypothesize
3. Do an experiment
4. Observe and record your data - Analyze data
5. Come to a Conclusion
6. Share your result
